The Squadron Operations Facility project began with the construction of a new two-story masonry block and structural steel building located in Fresno, California. The 24,000 square foot space developed into the headquarters of the 144th Fighter Squadron unit of the Air National Guard. The federal mission of the 144th Fighter Wing is to provide support for worldwide joint operations as well as air defense of the United States.
