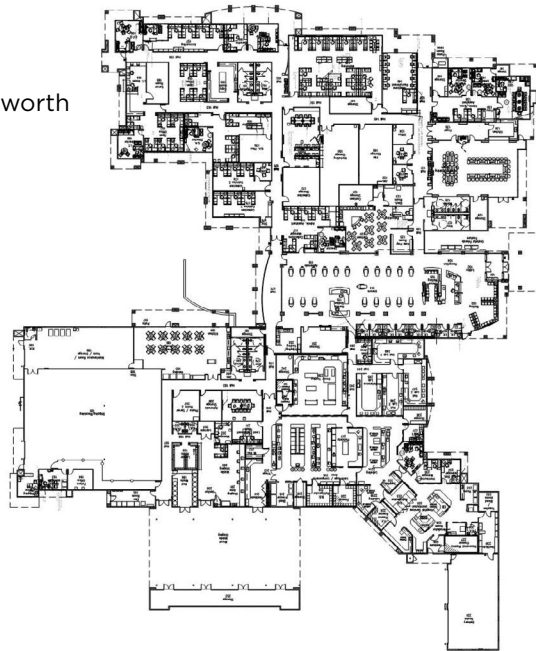
This wonderful facility will serve the community for many years to come.
